Mike Aubry - Director of Coaching

Mike grew up playing club soccer in the Toledo area before attending St. John's Jesuit High School. After graduating from SJJ in 1991 he enrolled at Miami University for a year before returning to the area to complete his undergraduate work at the University of Toledo. In 1996 Mike was instrumental in forming the Greater Toledo Futbol Club where he has been the Director of Coaching since 1997. In addition to his role with GTFC he has been an Ohio North State Team coach for several years and was the assistant varsity coach at Notre Dame Academy for two years. With strong roots in Northwest Ohio Mike continues to be the core of the most stable and consistent coaching staff in the area.

Molly Scott - IDL Director

Molly is a product of GTFC where she played for DOC Mike Aubry since an early age. Molly has shown tremendous growth and maturity in a short time. She was only 19 when she began coaching and is passionate both about coaching and GTFC Impact in general. Under Molly's supervision the Mini-Kickers program has grown to nearly triple it's previous record size.

Jim Scott - Staff Coach U8 - U10

Jim is a product of Northwest Ohio and has been involved in the youth scene for over a decade. He began his career as the President of Maumee Youth Soccer Association where he brought participation in their recreational program to levels that have since been unmatched. He is the director of foot skills at the Maumee Soccer Centre as well as on staff with the women's program at St. Ursula Academy. Jim's extensive experience with youth coaching, coupled with his relationship with St. Ursula allows him to identify what younger players need to be able to do technically in order to succeed tactically as older players.

IMPACT DEVELOPMENT LEAGUE: APRIL 7 - MAY 17

GTFC Impact is pleased to announce the inaugural season of the Impact Development League (IDL). The league is tailored to youth girls ages 4 - 8 of all experience levels. It is a great place to start a career or to enhance and develop existing skills. Teams will train twice a week for an hour and will play games in a 4 vs. 4 format on the weekends.

Training consists of technical training, enhanced athletic movement, balance and coordination. Each practice will culminate with fun and educational soccer games. Teams will be coached by GTFC Impact staff coaches and will follow a club curriculum to ensure that league development is held to a high standard.

This spring training will be held at the Perrysburg Soccer Fields located at Route 199, 25800 Scheider Rd. Perrysburg, OH 43551 on Tuesdays and Thursdays during the season. Games will be on Sunday afternoons.

April 7th and 9th will be IDL Boot Camp where the girls and parents will meet the staff, their team and their specific coach. T-shirts will be distributed and all players will get some basic skills instruction. The first official training session will be April 14th. The younger girls (ages 4 - 6) will train from 5 - 6 PM and then the older girls (ages 7 - 8) will train from 6 - 7 PM. Our league schedule begins April 19th and concludes May 17th.

There are no tryouts for the Impact Development League — All players are welcome!!! It is our goal to impact players in a way that gets them to learn the game in a fun, yet challenging environment. We hope to aid in your little player's growth and development to be the best soccer player they can be and help them foster an unending love for the game.

There are 3 ways to register for the league and **REGISTRATION IS NOW OPEN.** (1) You can register by mailing in this registration form along with payment to the address at the bottom of the form, (2) You can fill out this form and hand it to a GTFC Staff Coach or (3) You can register online at www.greatertoledofc.org/mini-kicker.

For added convenience, there are three options when registering your player. (1) You can register as an individual, (2) You can register with friends as a group (2 - 6 girls) or (3) You can register as a team (7 - 8 girls). Individual registration is \$40, group registration is \$35 per individual and team registration is \$30 per individual. All registration fees includes a team t-shirt.
